

500.0 Privileges and Responsibilities of Black Belt Rank

It is the responsibility of all Dan ranks :

to practice the Tenets of Taekwon Do: Courtesy, Integrity, Perseverance, Self Control and Indomitable Spirit;

to practice the ultimate purpose of Taekwon Do: to develop a perfect character and perfect physical condition;

to wear the appropriate Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College uniform whenever representing Taekwon Do;

to teach others to abide by the above rules by their example.

510.01 First Dans are eligible to apply for Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Instructor's Certification and, after certification, to teach Taekwon Do at a location approved by the State Director.

510.02 First Dans are eligible to attend an Officials' Seminar and be certified as a Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Judge, and, after certification, to participate as a judge at approved tournaments.

520.01 Second Dans, who have Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Instructor's Certification, may teach Taekwon Do at a location approved by the State Director.

520.02 Second Dans are eligible to attend an Official's Seminar and be certified as a Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Referee; after certification, they may participate as a referee at approved tournaments.

520.03 Second Dans are eligible to receive a rebate on their students' promotion test fees: \$5.00 per student promoted by their Examiner or State Director.

530.01 Third Dans, who have Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Instructor's Certification, may teach Taekwon Do at a location approved by the State Director.

530.02 Third Dans, who are certified as Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Judges and/or Referees, may officiate at approved tournaments.

530.03 Third Dans are eligible to receive a rebate on their students' promotion test fees: \$10.00 per student promoted by their Examiner or State Director.

540.01 Fourth Dans, who have Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Instructor's Certification, may teach Taekwon Do at a location approved by the State Director.

540.02 Fourth Dans, who are certified as Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Judges and/or Referees, may officiate at approved tournaments.

540.03 Fourth Dans have the option of becoming an Examiner: eligible to test their students and their students' students through First Kup, applying to the State Director for Kup certification at \$15.00 per certificate, and retaining \$25.00 for each Dan student sent to the State Director for testing.

540.04 Instructors down line from an Examiner, no longer have students tested by that Examiner, if:

1. the down line instructor opts to become an Examiner at Fourth Dan;
2. the down line instructor or his Examiner moves out of state.

540.05 Fourth Dans have the option not to become an Examiner and continue to have their students tested through First Kup by their Examiner or the State Director, retaining \$15.00 per Kup test and \$15.00 per Dan test.

540.06 Dan testing through Second Dan performed by State Examiner. Third Dan and above tests are performed by Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College president.

540.07 Fourth Dans, who move to a state or country unoccupied by a current State Director, may apply to Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do President to become that State's Director. Permission and training will be required. State Directors test up through Second Dan and apply to Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College president for Kup certification at \$5.00 per certificate and \$50.00 per Dan certificate.

540.08 Fourth Dan Examiners may apply to Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College president, in the fall of each year, for a tournament to be held the following year. Tournaments will be assigned by January and the assignment will be based on a combination of factors, including, but not limited to the following criteria: student enrollment during the year, student and Examiner participation at tournaments and seminars.

540.09 Fourth Dan Examiners may recommend their black belt students for Bailey's Traditional Taekwon Do College Instructor Certification. The Examiner will test his Certified Instructors' students unless the Certified Instructor becomes a Fourth Dan Examiner or the Certified Instructor or the Examiner move out of state. School locations must be approved by the State Director to prevent instructors from opening schools too close together.
